

From The Rector's Desk

It is our time. It is our week.

This is our 8th Holy Week together. If you've been around for most of those, you've heard me do all I can to invite you fully into Holy Week. We have Eucharist at noon on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday (with Stations of the Cross at 11:30 Wednesday). I think it is important to have Holy Eucharist on the days of Holy Week, this year we have moved them to noon vs. our usual evening time, in hopes more of you will be able to attend. These services are in the chapel.


Thursday begins the **Triduum**, those three services designed as one long worship experience. Maundy Thursday has so much meaning and symbolism. At this service we reenact Jesus' washing of the disciples' feet. This powerful moment can stir our souls, humble us, and remind us we are called to servant ministry AND we must allow others to serve us at times as well. We end the evening with the stripping of the altar and the preservation of the reserved sacrament (which is watched over by praying parishioners all night). The altar stripping reminds us Jesus has been arrested in the garden of Gethsemane and taken before Pilate and the Sanhedrin to be tried as a criminal. As the sanctuary candle is extinguished we turn all the lights out for a brief yet startling moment, before we leave in silence, contemplating what we have just experienced while our hearts and minds are with Christ.

This year we will have the Good Friday liturgy, including veneration of the cross, at noon only. At six that evening we will again walk the Stations of the Cross, which always has an even deeper meaning when done on Good Friday.

The Triduum concludes with the Great Vigil of Easter, the Mother of all liturgies. We begin at 5:30am Sunday morning in the outdoor chapel, hear stories of our salvation history in the darkness, baptize a beautiful baby girl, and then shout the first ALLELUIAS of Easter as the sun rises over the Sound. Our Easter Day services are at 8 and 10:30, with our wonderful choir, led by the incomparable John Leatherwood for his last Sunday with us as Choir Director. The church is beautifully decorated by our amazing Flower Guild and Altar Guild. We ring bells to all the Alleluias and proclaim Christ, Risen Indeed. This Easter Sunday is also our last time to be served by our amazing Deacon, The Reverend Clelia Garrity. I know you will join me in wishing all the best for John and Clelia.

Beloved in Christ, with commercialization overtaking many of our religious celebrations, I always hope Holy Week can be kept sacred for us, especially the **Triduum**. I have said many times, I believe I became an Episcopalian, not at my Confirmation, but when I danced all the dances of Holy Week for the first time, and it all came together for me deep in my soul. I pray you can join us on that journey.




