## Roof Repair Frequently Asked Questions

### St. Simon's on the Sound

#### 2025 Roof Repair

**1. Will the AC units need to be removed/alterd to apply the silicone?**

**No.** There is a process to ensure that all AC units get special attention to ensure proper sealing.

**2. The bell tower could prove particularly challenging. Could they clean all rust from the steel framing and then seal the metal in silicone, along with sealing the entire bell tower flat roof?**

**Yes,** this will not be a problem and was included in the final quote.

**3. If the silicon is applied before the shingle roof is completed, will that result in a lot of rework?**

**No,** as we will get a 20-year warranty for the work, they are willing to be on site to ensure no damage is experienced and to fix anything that may go wrong, regardless of who performs the shingle work. That would be part of the shingle effort in the future.

**4. There has been substantial leaking over the choir room, and we believe the steeple may have something to do with that. What do they (Sherwood Roofing) recommend?**

Sherwood Roofing has prior experience with other steeples and has had great results. The steeple was included in the final quote.

**5. Can something be done to help the skylights over the Chapel and the Church hallway?**

**Yes,** they can clean and seal with clear silicone.

**6. Given the nature of the product, are there special protective applications that can help prevent damage, particularly for tasks like AC repair?**

**Yes,** they can apply “walking pads” for high-density areas that are basically the application, but with a binder that makes the solution more robust.

**7. What is the total cost with a twenty-year warranty?**

\$45,310 with a twenty-year warranty

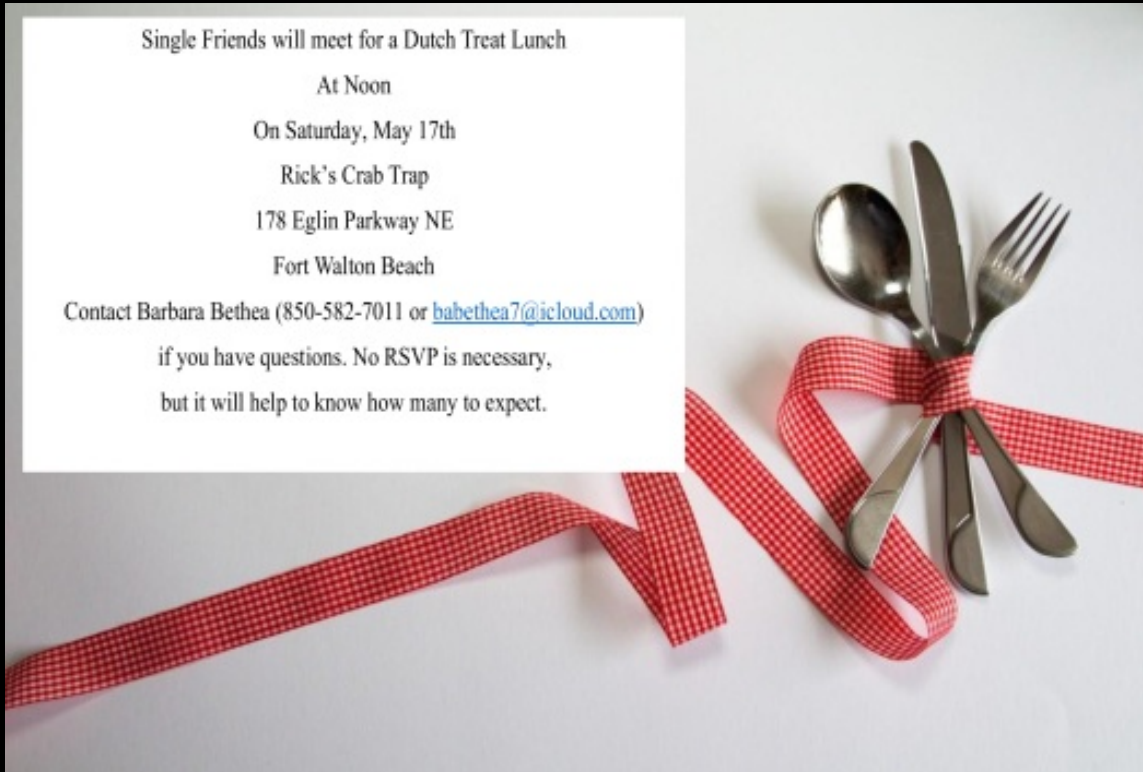

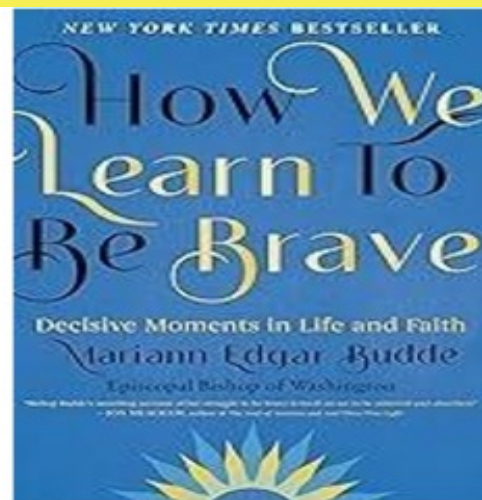
